

What to Expect From School

Free services are available

Kids diagnosed with a physical or mental health condition including developmental delays, ADHD, anxiety, autism, and dyslexia may qualify for free school-based services.

Free services at school include:

- Academic help for reading, writing, and math delays
- Social and behavioral skills
- Speech and language therapy
- Occupational therapy for handwriting or sensory needs
- Physical therapy to help students access the school environment



Programs for ages...

- Early Intervention Services for age 0-3
- Early Childhood Special Education age 3-5
- Special Education for kindergarten through age 21

Request an Evaluation

Parents may request a school evaluation if they are concerned that their child may need special education services. Talk to the teacher and principal to request an evaluation or share information about a diagnosis.

IEP and 504

Kids who need specialized teaching to help them make progress may qualify for a special education plan - an Individualized Education Program or IEP.

Kids who don't need specialized teaching, but need certain strategies or tools to help them learn in the classroom, may qualify for a 504 Accommodation Plan.
